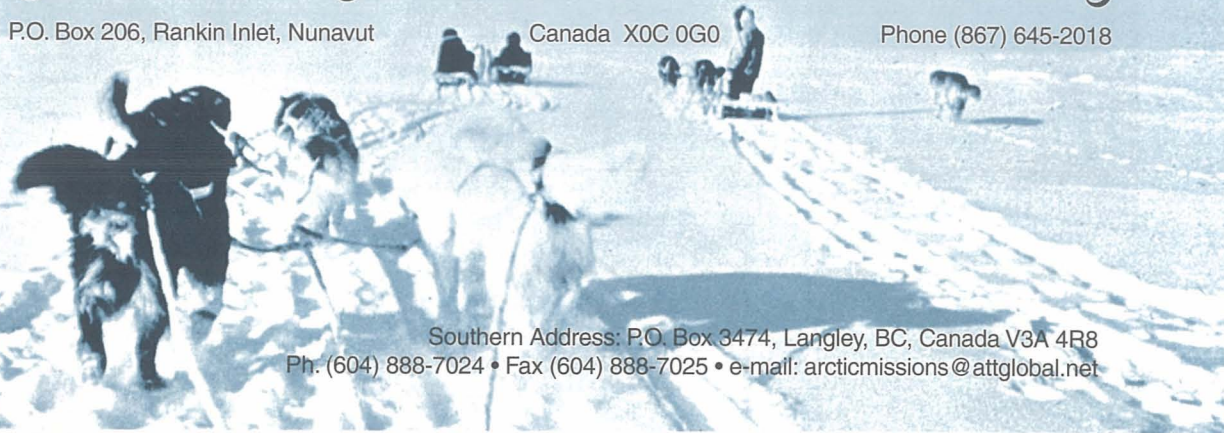

A group of 13 "on fire" Inuit from the Eastern Arctic led by Pastor Hattie from Arviat, flew in to help us in the services and outreach to the village. Others came from Vancouver to minister to the children and young people. One speaker even came from Hawaii, and a gospel singer from Texas!! What a wonderful time we had all together!

Each time the Inuit gathered in the Community Hall, and then in the church, the Holy spirit moved powerfully and many opened their hearts to Jesus and were saved; others were wonderfully filled with the Holy Spirit. A new freedom and joy flooded many lives...what a delight to see their faces light up with enthusiasm for God! We all rejoiced and praised God celebrating Jesus together! Thank you so much for all your prayers and financial support to help make this all happen!

Our vision was also to cover the village with the Word of God...in every home. Many bibles were given out, but because of 5 days of severe blizzard conditions, all the bibles did not arrive in time.
