
Pastor Lynn and I have just returned from a trip to Arctic villages, but due to ongoing blizzards, the airline flights were cancelled and our travel plans changed several times. But it was worth it all to reach Arviat (on the shores of Hudson's Bay), and see the **fire of Holy Spirit** burning brightly.

During the special meetings there, night after night, the altar was crowded with so many hungry-hearted Inuit, young and old, reaching out to the Lord. The *prophetic* word of the Lord came encouraging many...the *joy* of the Lord overflowed as a powerful *anointing* of the Holy Spirit refreshed many lives. What an exciting time to see the church overflowing with people even during the week night services!!

I had the special honour of dedicating a beautiful baby, "little Kayy" named after me. In Inuit tradition this is a very great honour. It was such a joyful event joining the mother, Howmik, and the extended family including great grandmother, Pastor Hattie, as we presented "little Kayy" to the Lord.







We were given a warm invitation to Coral Harbour to be with Pastors Ron and Leonie Duffy. We had our tickets, but the **BIG WINDS** blew again delaying our visit until a later time. But we believe "God is not early, God is never late, God is always on time!." Recently, wonderful reports have come in from Coral Harbour of such hunger for God that they are having not one, but three Bible studies a week, as well as a prayer meeting and weekly services. That village is moving in revival and more souls coming to Jesus!

Baker Lake was another village on our itinerary...but more storms and cancelled flights made it impossible at that time. However, two of our experienced and musically talented pastors, *David and Dorothy Aglukark* are heading to Baker Lake for special meetings at Easter. The people at Baker love them, so let's believe God for great things! Will you help us send these Inuit teams to the communities? The airfare is very expensive but air travel is the only highway to these villages in the north!

This week Pastor Hattie is taking part in a Conference in *Pangnirtung, Nunavut*. It is the very first "*Holy Spirit Conference*" there. We hear that many dear Anglican and Catholic people are searching for a deeper experience with God. Please join us in believing prayer that the Lord will *light the fire of Holy Spirit* in many lives.

In January the Bible School at Rankin Inlet will begin a *Leadership Training* program. We do need sponsors to help students from other settlements attend. This School was raised up to train Leaders to go forth with the gospel. We do need your continued prayers and financial support...together we will see a great *harvest of souls!!*
